Foremen direct crews and subcontractors on every project. They are responsible for crew safety, maintaining quality control and maximizing efficiency throughout the project.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Responsible for crew safety and compliance with safety standards.
- Conduct weekly safety meetings with crew.
- Direct crews and subcontractors.
- Assure competency and capability of crew members.
- Maintain quality control to ensure that completed work meets quality standards.
- Interpret plans and specifications to ensure work is performed in compliance.
- Sequence work to assure maximum efficiency.
- Assess look-ahead schedules and identify needs, deficiencies, and potential conflicts.
- Communicate with Project Management and understand objectives.
- Communicate with the Owner/Engineer as required.
- Maintain reports of crew activities and time worked.

Job Requirements

- Minimum of three (3) to five (5) years' experience supervising installation of underground utilities.
- Willingness to work alongside the crew.
- Must possess a clean driver's license.

- Must be able to read and interpret plans and specifications.
- Must have excellent communication skills.

- Must be willing to work in hot and cold work environments.

- Must have advanced experience in working with elevations, setting up lasers, provide layout, ability to work with bench marks, shoot grades, calculate concrete and dirt quantities, etc.
