



Heavy Equipment Operator

The Heavy Equipment Operator is responsible for the safe and efficient operation of heavy construction equipment including track hoe, frontend loader, off-road trucks, dozers, cranes, compactors and other support equipment.

Specific responsibilities:

- Follow basic daily maintenance practices including fueling, checking oil and fluids, greasing equipment, cleaning tracks, maintaining clean cab.
- Perform daily pre-and-post inspections with appropriate documentation in compliance with company policies.
- Safely and efficiently operate a variety of heavy equipment pieces used on construction projects including track hoe, frontend loader, off-road trucks, dozers, cranes, compactors, and other support equipment.
- Operator will be responsible for a safe work environment for themselves and co-workers.
- Properly follow all company policies and OSHA regulations for safe working procedures and environment.
- Follow directions of Foreman as to daily tasks and expectations for each specific project or job site.
- Perform minor servicing and maintenance of equipment; refer major problems to the Foreman.
- Assist in training less-experienced employees on the proper operations, servicing and repair of equipment to further their abilities.

- Minimum 4 years' experience operating heavy equipment including track hoe, frontend loader, off-road trucks, dozers, cranes, compactors and other support equipment.
